







Setting up News Forums & general Forums

1. News Forum

To set up the **News forum**, which appears on all courses by default, **Turn editing on** and click on the  icon beside the News forum. Here, you can update the **Name** and **Summary** - used to explain what the forum is for. When ready, click [Save changes](#)



To start a new topic, click

[Add a new topic](#)

Give your topic a **Subject**, then write and format your **Message**. You can also add an **attachment**. When ready, click [Post to forum](#)



Click on the **News forum** to see how the topic is displayed. To **Reply** to a topic, click the name of the discussion topic (leaving the subject the same) or you can add a new topic by clicking on the News forum.

NB if you wish to remove the News Forum from your course, you can hide it by clicking on the  icon beside the News Forum.

To *permanently* delete the News Forum, go to the Settings block and follow this path:

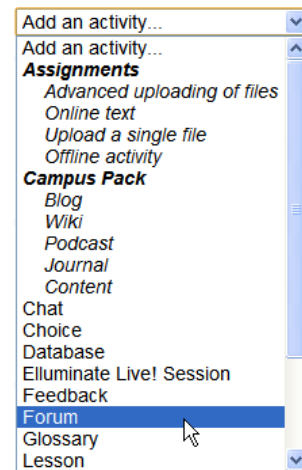
Course administration>Edit settings>News items to show

Set the value to 0 and then delete the News Forum from the course page.



2. Forums for general use


The **Forum** is an activity where students and teachers can exchange ideas by posting comments. A Forum can contribute significantly to successful communication and community-building in an online environment. Once you have opened your course, **Turn editing on**, and decide where you want your Forum to appear. Then click the **Add an activity...** and choose the option **Forum**.



The text editor box appears and here you will need to type in a **Forum name**. Leave the **Forum type** set to *Standard forum for general use*. Type a **Forum introduction** to describe the purpose of the Forum. Students will see this text when they click on the Forum.



From the drop-down boxes, you can organise how you want students to reply and post to the Forum. You can also specify how students will be subscribed from the **Subscription mode**. When a participant is subscribed to a Forum, it means they will receive email copies of forum posts. There are four options to choose from:



Optional subscription: users choose whether to be subscribed;
Forced subscription: All are subscribed and cannot unsubscribe;
Auto subscription: All are subscribed initially but can choose to unsubscribe at any time;
Subscription disabled: Subscriptions are not allowed.

When ready, scroll down the page, click [Save and return to course](#) to return to your course and **Turn editing off** to see the final result.
