

Adding quizzes in Moodle

Add an activity Campus Pack

To add a quiz in a topic, turn on editing, click **Add an activity...** and select **Quiz**

Give the quiz a meaningful **Name** and in the **Introduction**, explain clearly what the students have to do, provide any prequiz requirements, etc. You can use the text editor to add links, images, etc. There are several options available; the most useful ones are described here:

<u>Timing</u> - you can choose when the quiz is available to students by setting the open date/time; to do this you will need to tick the **Enable** box.

When a close date/time is set, Moodle will automatically submit the quiz after this time expires. The student is warned when time is running out.

<u>Time limit</u> – by default, quizzes do not have a time limit. To set a quiz under timed conditions, click **Enable** and specify the time limit (the units of time available are *days*, *hours*, *minutes* and *seconds*).

<u>Attempts</u> – set the number of attempts you want your students to have (from *unlimited* to *10 attempts*). Formative (self test) quizzes will usually allow multiple attempts, summative (exam condition) quizzes usually allow one.

<u>Grades</u> – how the attempts (if more than one) are graded (i.e. *Highest*, *Average*, *First* or *Last*).


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<u>Layout</u> - shuffling (randomising) the questions and choices within each question helps stop repetition and predictable patterns.

<u>Review options</u> – enables you to control what information students will be shown they review past attempts or look at quiz reports. Information that can be controlled in these ways:

The attempt: what the student entered in response to each question.

Whether correct: correct answer to each question.

Marks: score the student receives on each question.

Specific feedback: feedback that is specific to the student's response to each question.

General feedback: general feedback for the question, which does not depend on the student's response.

Overall feedback: overall feedback for the whole attempt.

You can determine when the students will see each of these items: **Immediately after the attempt** is within 2 minutes of the student clicking "submit all and finish".

Later, while the quiz is still open is after 2 minutes, but before the close date (if the quiz does not have a close date, this phase never ends).

After the quiz is closed is what it says (you never get here for quizzes without a close date).

Users with the capability 'View hidden grades' (typically teachers and administrators) are not affected by these settings and will always be able to review all information about a student's attempt at any time.
