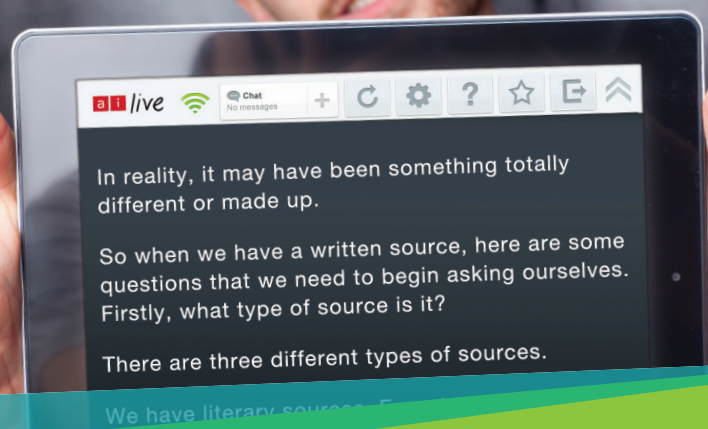




# Live captions for your education.



## What is Ai-Live?

Real-time captions streamed to a web-enabled device. A transcript is available after each lesson.

## How does it help?

Ai-Live helps people learn and participate by enabling inclusion and access to lessons, lectures and seminars.

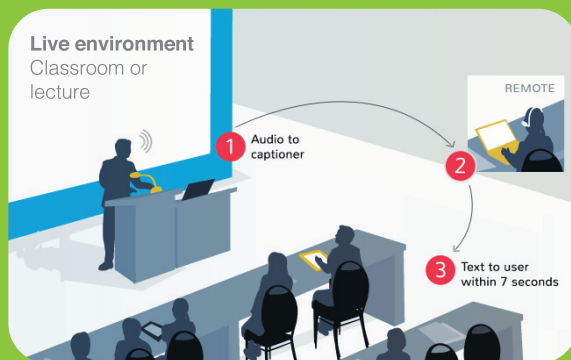

**Features of Ai-Live** include:

- Access to the text in real time via captions and transcripts can support literacy, language, learning and understanding.
- Captions can be displayed on an interactive white-board for the whole classroom, and/or on tablets or laptops, accessed by individual or small groups of pupils.
- The pupil or teacher can scroll backwards during a lesson to review or display specific information.
- Captions can enable teachers to focus on the whole class rather than individual pupils.
- Transcripts eliminate the need to make notes, and can be used to help with homework and revision.
- Captioning and transcripts can support teachers in reflecting on and developing their practice. They can be used for teacher training and quality assurance.
- Deaf pupils can follow what is being said in real-time.
- Pupils with learning difficulties, such as dyslexia, can use the captioning to assist with following the lesson, understanding and reviewing instructions.
- Pupils with a visual learning preference can benefit from real time text and customised viewing experience.
